- Earthquake in Sisak Moslavina County, 29 December 2020



EARTHQUAKE IN ZAGREB 22 MARCH 2020




A STADIO



March 22, 2020 (Sunday) at 6:24 a.m.

- 5.5 on the Richter scale the epicentre 7 kilometres north of the centre of Zagreb (Markuševec), at a depth of 10 km
- 1 person died, 27 injured, major damage to buildings
- Activation of emergency services / operational civil protection teams, military, etc. (search and rescue, evacuation, sheltering)

- Challenge:
 - operating in COVID-19 environment
- March 22 activation of the UCPM





EARTHQUAKE IN SISAK-MOSLAVINA COUNTY 29 DECEMBER 2020











December 29, 12:19 p.m.

- 6.4 magnitude earthquake (after 5.2 magnitude earthquake the day before)
- 7 people died, 28 injured, several thousand people lost their homes
- significant structural damage in Sisak, Petrinja, Glina and neighbouring villages
- December 29 activation of the UCPM

Material assistance requested and Copernicus activated:

- Winter tents 500 pcs
- Balloons / light towers 50 pcs
- Electric heaters 500 pcs
- Folding beds 5000 pcs
- Sleeping bags 5000 pcs
- Residential containers (100 + 100)

- Covid-19 environment
- Weather conditions winter
