

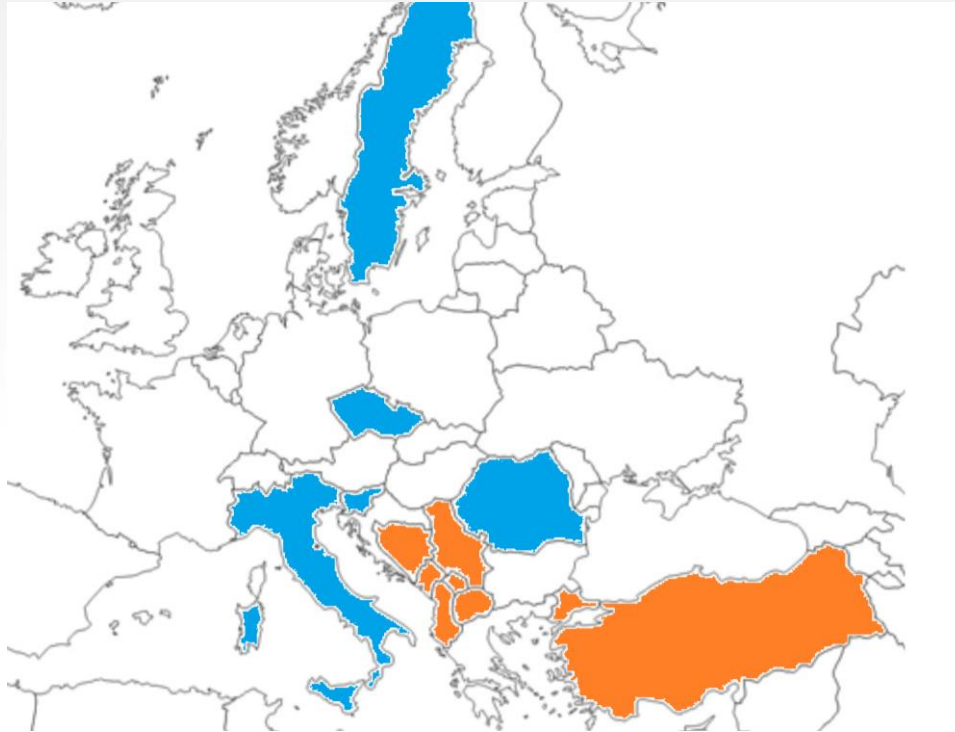

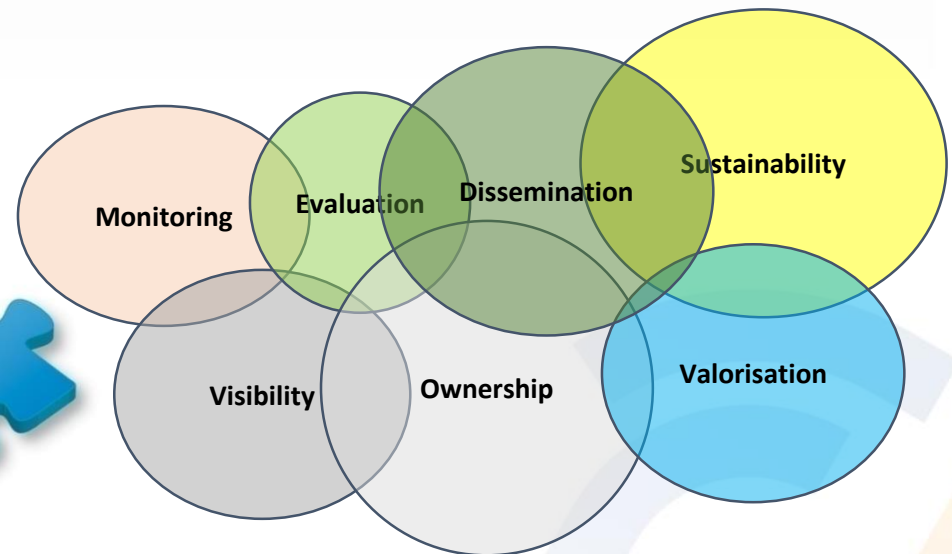
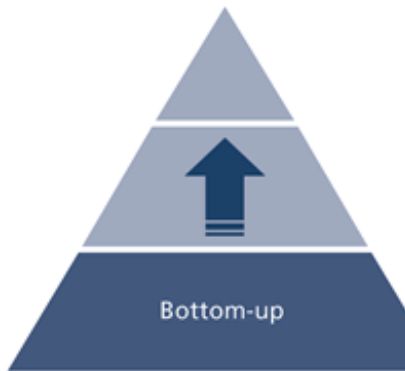

1.3 EW in central/local ERPs Lead partner: CIMA, Italy	Support for integration of EW into ERP and upgrading of forecast/EW capabilities of NHMSs
