







Final Workshop on Disaster Inventory Management System: DesInventar

Albania, Tirana, 6 - 7 March 2014

Report

During the 6th and 7th of March 2014, the DPPI SEE, UNISDR and CIMA Foundation organised the Final Workshop on Disaster Inventory Management System: DesInventar for purpose of presenting the historical inventory on losses caused by disasters in Albania. The workshop was hosted by the General Directorate for the Civil Emergencies – Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Albania and represented Albanian contribution to the **Disaster Training Management Programme (DTMP) of DPPI SEE.** The workshop was attended and presentations delivered by representatives of civil protection services of **Albania**, **Bosnia and Herzegovina**, **Bulgaria**, **Croatia**, **Macedonia**, **Montenegro and Serbia**.

The data on disaster losses in Albania have been collected by using the DesInventar methodology, a conceptual and methodological tool to build databases on the impact and losses caused by emergencies or catastrophes. For the construction of the historical database of Albania 4 main sources of data have been used: i) Ministry of Internal Affairs; ii) National Library; iii) State Archive; iv) Institute of Geosciences, Energy, Water and Environment (IGEWE).

The historical database covers the period going from 1851 regarding earthquakes and the period from 1945 for all the other disaster types.
